1.0 Purpose

1.0 At the Hampton Vale Primary Academy we pride ourselves in not only what we do but also how smart we look. Therefore, all children are expected to wear a school uniform as detailed in this document. Children should wear their school uniform when attending school, or when participating in a school-organised event outside of school.

2.0 Uniform

1.1 It is not a requirement that uniform displays the school logo and uniform can be purchased from any shop. However the uniform does need to be in the Academy's colours which are royal blue and white.

1.2 If you wish your child/ren to wear a school uniform displaying Hampton Vale Primary Academy's logo it can be purchased from the school shop via the parent/carer's MCAS app. All available uniform is shown on the app. All purchases made during term time will be delivered to the child's classroom for them to take home. During the summer holidays orders can be collected directly from the school office. As we are a cashless school we are unable to accept orders directly through the school office. Orders and payments are taken on the MCAS app.

1.3 Children are to wear a white polo shirt or shirt with a collar, these can show the school logo or be plain. All white tops ordered through the school shop will be embroidered with the HVPA logo.

1.4 Cardigans and jumpers are royal blue, these can show the school logo or be plain. All cardigans or jumpers ordered through the school shop will be embroidered with the HVPA logo.

1.5 Children are to wear grey skirts or trousers/shorts with grey or white socks/ tights. In summer, blue and white checked school dresses or playsuits are acceptable.

1.6 Children are to wear smart black shoes. Trainers are not to be worn unless it is for P.E. In the summer black sandals can be worn, but for health and safety reasons they must have a back and be done up.

1.7 PE uniform is royal blue shorts with a white t-shirt. The t-shirt can be plain or show the school logo. All white tops ordered through the school shop will be embroidered with the HVPA logo. Trainers are to be worn for P.E. When the weather is cold, children need warm and waterproof clothing as PE will be taught outside. Children can wear plain dark coloured (e.g. black, navy or grey) jogging bottoms and hoodies/sweatshirts. Hoodies should only be worn for PE and not during normal class time. Children can also wear gloves and hats. Younger children will also wear coats for P.E. when it is raining or very cold.

1.8 A book bag or rucksack is recommended for your child/ren to safely and responsibly take care of their school belongings.

1.9 Please make sure that everything your child wears and brings to school is marked clearly with their name. Please regularly check to make sure these labels are still legible and have not washed/worn out. This way items are easier to trace if they go missing.

1.10 Long hair below shoulder length should be tied back securely while in school. Hair bands should be blue, white or grey and should be discreet. These can be purchased through the school shop via the MCAS app.

1.11 Hair must be of a natural colour.

1.12 Jewellery: One stud/ sleeper in each ear only. No other jewellery is allowed except for watches or any items worn for religious reasons. For Health and Safety reasons we ask that jewellery is removed or covered on the days children have PE.

3.0 Previous school logo branded uniform

3.1 Children can still wear uniform with the old logo until you are ready to replace them

4.0 Second hand school uniform

4.1 If you require support with purchasing uniform, the school has good quality second hand items of all uniform available. Please speak to the school office for more information.

5.0 Monitoring and Review

5.1 Unless any other reason, this policy will not be reviewed for 3 years.

School Uniform

Please ensure your child comes to school everyday wearing the correct school uniform.

Acceptable attire includes:

- *royal blue jumpers and cardigans*
- *blue gingham dress*
- *black or grey trousers*
- *black or grey shorts*
- *black or grey knee-length skirts*
- *white polo shirt*
- *smart black school shoes*



P.E. Kit & Other Items



Acceptable P.E. attire includes:

- plain white t-shirt
- royal blue shorts
- sport trainers
- royal blue hoodie
- black, navy, or grey jogging bottoms

White t-shirts, school book bags, P.E. kit bags, and rucksacks embossed with the school logo can be purchased through the MCAS app.
