### **Assistant Headteacher Update**



The Reception children have had a busy two weeks full of learning and experiences. Our topic of 'Myself, My Family, My Community' has continued and we are now learning about people who help us in our community. We have had a big focus on the emergency services and finding out what police officers, firefighters and paramedics do to help us. The children have used their knowledge to create information videos in writing to explain the importance of these people. It has been an excellent opportunity for children to practise speaking in sentences and developing their vocabulary. We looked at different emergency scenarios and role played calling the emergency services to ask for help. Thank you for all the junk modelling resources, the children have thoroughly enjoyed creating a range of emergency vehicles. Next week, we will be focusing on other important jobs within our community, such as postal workers, shopkeepers and refuse collectors.

In Maths, we have introduced number to the children; 0, 1, 2 and 3. The children practised forming each number, as well as using a range of resources to represent each number. The children have specific maths packs to use for number in their maths lessons which include; numicon, tens frame, dice, bead strings and cubes. Next week, we will be counting various objects and introducing subitising to the children. Subitising is when you are able to look at a group of object and know how many are there without having to count. We are sure all the children are up to the challenge!

Our phonics has continued with the children being introduced to more phonemes; o, n, d, k, c and g. We have been focusing on segmenting and blending words in order for the children to develop their reading skills. Hopefully, the children have been showing you what they have learnt by segmenting and blending the words in their reading books they have been bringing home. Remember to bring the books every Friday in order for us to change them to a new books.






Well done to everyone for getting involved and working so hard in your performing arts lessons! I am so proud of each and everyone of you!




