The visit allowed the children to experience the historical importance of the the estate and learn more about the lifestyle of the Royal family. The children learnt that the estate was initially purchased by Queen Victoria and has remained a key holiday home for the Royal family. When having a guided tour of the house, the children learnt that Christmas is celebrated by the royal family at Sandringham. There are 12 Christmas trees that go up in the house and the children visited different rooms that have significant importance to the Royal family. Year 1 even saw the dining room where the royal family eat their Christmas dinner! As well as a tour of the house, the children enjoyed exploring the beautiful gardens and playing on the large play park. It was a very exciting and informative day for Year 1. Members of the public and staff at the house commented on how beautifully behaved all the children were. We are incredibly proud of all of them!

In writing, the children will be using their experience of the trip to write a recount of what happened. They will be using images that were taken throughout the day to support their writing. There was wonderful vocabulary used by the children throughout the day so I am sure this will be evident in their writing. I can't wait to see the informative recounts the children write.

In Maths, the children have moved onto addition and subtraction. They have been looking at part-part-whole models to support their understanding of addition and subtraction. The children have linked this knowledge to recalling the different fact families for each number to 10 as well as applying their number to 10 knowledge in a variety of ways.
