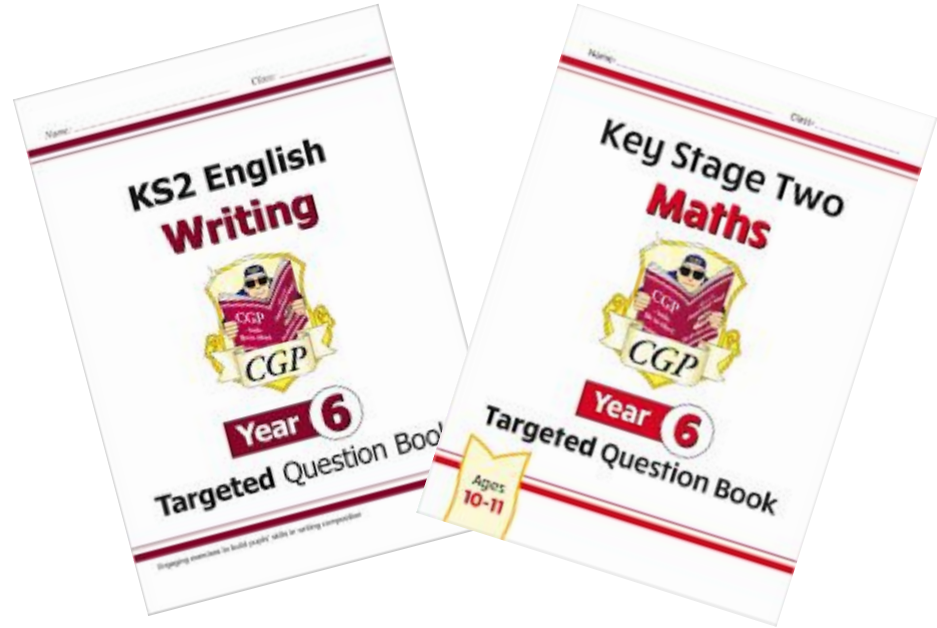
The sessions will be 45 minutes long and will start after half term. These will continue to run after the half term but further communication will be sent closer to the time.

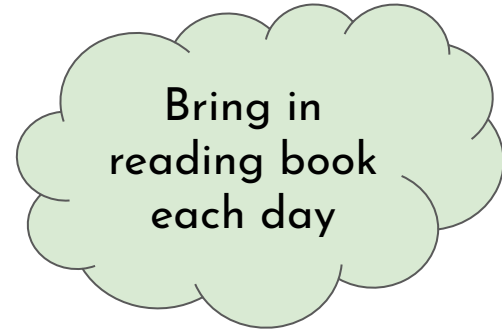

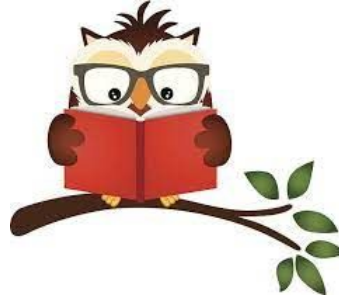
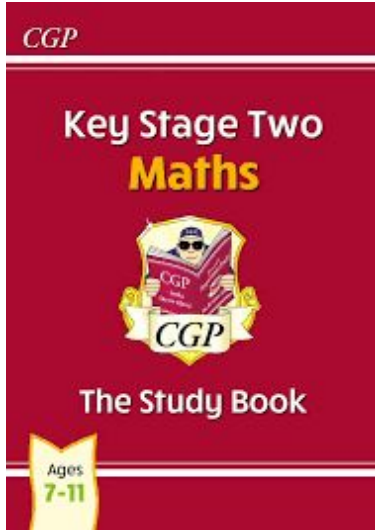

Secondary School Applications

The secondary schools admissions process is now open for children in Peterborough transferring from primary school to secondary school in 2025.



The application process closes on 31st October 2024. The easiest way to apply is online. Go to <https://www.peterborough.gov.uk/residents/schools-and-education/school-admissions/starting-secondary-school-in-year-7> and follow the instructions on screen.

If you apply before the closing date - you will receive your child's school place offer on **3 March 2025.**

If your application is late, your child is less likely to get into their preferred school.
